e. Yes, it will.
2. Will there be many mosquitoes?
h. Yes, there will.
3. Will Lizzie be able to go clubbing?
d. No, she won't.
4. Will she like the food?
c. She might like it. She might not like it.
5. Will she feel homesick?
f. She might miss her family. She can't be sure.
6. Is Lizzie's mum sure she'll be ill?
a. No, she isn't, but it's possible.
7. What will Lizzie take every day?
i. Some special tablets.
8. What other promises does she make?
g. She'll contact her parents regularly.
9. Will Martin forget about Lizzie?
b. No. He'll write to her every week.

- Lizzie **will contact** her parents regularly.
- Lizzie **might not like** the food.

It'll be very hot in Kenya.
You **probably won't** like the food.
*WILL ali ... + glagol uporabimo, kadar smo prepričani o nečem, kar se bo zgodilo v prihodnosti.
Probably in ... ali ... uporabimo, če nismo popolnoma prepričani.*

Lizzie **might** be ill. They don't know.
She **might not** like it.
MIGHT ali ... + glagol uporabimo, kadar ne vemo, kaj se bo zgodilo. G 15b, d, 20

4. Zapiši v zvezek:

Naslov: WILL, PROBABLY WILL, MIGHT

Prepričani.

Glede na to, kako prepričani smo o nečem v prihodnosti, lahko uporabimo naslednje:

- **WILL** – kadar smo zelo prepričani oziroma kadar nekaj obljubimo.

Lizzie will contact her parents regularly (Lizzie bo redno v stiku s starši). – ker je tako obljubila, smo prepričani.

Nismo prepričani.

- **PROBABLY WILL** – kadar nismo popolnoma prepričani.

Lizzie **will probably** miss her boyfriend (Lizzie bo verjetno pogrešala svojega fanta). – nismo popolnoma prepričani.

Lizzie **probably won't** like the food (Lizzie verjetno ne bo všeč hrana). – nismo prepričani.

Pazi na vrstni red → v trdilnih stavkih stoji probably za will, v nikalnih pa pred won't (glej zgoraj).

Ne vemo.

- **MIGHT** – kadar ne vemo

Lizzie might catch malaria. (Lizzie lahko zboli za malarijo). – ne vemo, lahko se zgodi ali pa ne.
